

Advisory Committees

Advisory committees will be appointed for specific terms and for specific tasks. The problem assigned will be carefully delineated in writing. The Administrator or designee shall name a member of the professional staff to serve as needed as a liaison between the committee and school authorities. This staff member shall make available to the committee necessary resource material as requested. Final recommendations of advisory committees will be made in writing to the Charter Board.

An advisory committee member shall be removed from office if that member does not attend three consecutive meetings unless the committee by resolution approves any additional absences or unless such absences are due to temporary disability or illness. In addition, the committee by majority vote may request the removal from office of any member. Such removal shall be made by the Administrator or designee with approval of the Charter Board.

Arrangements for the use of supplies, equipment, building space and personnel from within the school system shall be made through the liaison person assigned by the Administrator or designee. Expenditures of Charter School funds by any advisory committee shall be made only upon prior approval of the Administrator or designee.

All such committees are advisory bodies whose recommendations will be considered in relation to the total school picture by the Charter Board. The legal responsibility for final decisions rests with the Charter Board. After careful consideration, the Charter Board may find that for the best interest of the charter school, committee recommendations cannot be implemented at a given time. Any publicity concerning the advisory committees will be released by the Charter Board through the Administrator.

If required by state law, advisory committee meetings shall be open to the public and meeting notices shall be posted. If notice of the meeting is legally required, such notice shall be posted in the same place and manner as notices of Charter Board meetings.
