

Handbooks and Directives

In order that pertinent Charter Board policies, [charter school](#) regulations and/or school rules may be known by all staff members and students affected by them, [charter school](#) administrators are granted authority to issue staff and student handbooks as found necessary and desirable.

It is essential that the contents of all handbooks conform with district-wide policies and regulations. It also is important that all handbooks bearing the name of the charter school ~~or one of its schools~~ be of a quality that reflects credit on the [charter school](#). Therefore, the Charter Board expects all handbooks to be approved by the Charter Board and/or [administrator](#) prior to publication.

The Charter Board shall review and approve the charter school-wide personnel handbooks and the student handbooks so that the contents of both may be accorded the status of Charter Board-approved policy and regulation. The [administrator](#) shall use ~~personal~~ judgment as to whether other specific handbooks need Charter Board approval. However, all handbooks published shall be made available to the Charter Board for informational purposes.
