

Staff Involvement in Decision-making

The charter school believes that staff members play an important role in decision-making for the charter school. Staff members are encouraged to participate in the setting of charter school educational objectives by the charter school and in determining appropriate strategies for achieving the objectives.

Staff Advisory Functions

The administrator shall include staff in decision making processes, when feasible, and in the development of regulations and procedures for the charter school. The administrator shall develop channels for effective communication between and among the staff and the administration. The administrator shall weigh, with care, the counsel given by employees, especially given by groups designated to represent large segments of the staff, and shall inform the Charter Board of all such counsel in presenting reports of administrative action and recommendations for Charter Board action.

Staff Advisory Committees

So that joint advice may be readily available for the purpose described above, the staff shall be encouraged to elect advisory committees to work with the administrator in the areas of concern to staff. Furthermore, the administrator shall, at his/her discretion, appoint additional committees as needed.
