

Vacation Policy for Custodial Employees

Custodial employees are entitled to paid vacation for a period determined by Charter Board policy.

Custodians employed up to five years with the [charter school](#) shall receive two weeks of vacation. Custodians employed six years and over with the [charter school](#) shall receive three weeks of vacation, and those employed ten years and over shall receive four weeks of vacation.

All vacation time earned by all employees in the previous fiscal year shall be taken upon approval by the [administrator of the charter school](#), unless a deferred vacation is approved by the [administrator of the school](#).

Vacations shall be scheduled at the convenience of the [charter school](#) and as nearly as possible at the convenience of the employee. All summer vacation schedules shall be arranged for all employees and reviewed with the [administrator](#).

New employees whose term of service is less than one full year shall be entitled to paid vacation in the ratio that their length of service bears to a full year.
