

Environmental and Safety Program

It shall be the policy of the Charter Board to guard against accidents by taking reasonable precautions to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present on charter school property or at school-sponsored events.

The Charter Board shall insist that its staff adhere to recommended safety practices as these pertain to the school plant, special areas of instruction, student transportation, school sports, occupational safety, etc.

The practice of safety also shall be considered a facet of the instructional program of the charter schools, and instruction in accident prevention as well as fire prevention; emergency procedures; traffic, bicycle and pedestrian safety, and driver education shall be provided in the appropriate grades and classes.

Administrator's shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for their schools. The administrator shall have overall responsibility for the safety program of the charter school. It shall be the responsibility of the administrator to see that appropriate staff members are kept informed of current state and local requirements relating to fire prevention, civil defense, sanitation, public health and occupational safety.
