

Purchasing/Purchasing Authority

The Charter Board's authority for the purchase of materials, equipment, supplies, and services is extended to the [administrator](#) through the detailed listing of such items compiled as part of the budget making process and approved by the Charter Board through its adoption of the annual operating budget.

Except in emergencies or for reason of economy, the annual purchase of major pieces of equipment such as school buses shall be scheduled so that annual budgetary appropriations for capital purposes will be of similar size or will show a continuous trend without severe fluctuations.

The [administrator](#) shall direct the purchase of such books, supplies, equipment, and other materials as is required and permitted within the limits of the budget. The purchase of these items shall require no further Charter Board approval except in those instances where Board policy requires certain purchases to be put to bid. However, in the case of any unusual expenditures, the Charter Board always should be consulted.

In order to receive the greatest value for each dollar expended, it shall be the policy of the [charter school](#) to purchase in quantity whenever possible and practical.
