- Want to be more involved in LGCS but don't know how you can help? Consider joining a Committee! Committees are where a lot of the "real work" gets done and there is an open invitation to the public to attend any of the important committees that help our School function efficiently. Below are the typical meeting days for each of the Committee. Contact any of the board members for additional information or to see if times or dates have changed. Meetings typically start at 4:30pm.
 - 1st Tues – Development Committee focuses on marketing, growth, PR and grants.
 - 2nd Tues – BAC evaluates the school's academic progress and considers whether personnel or infrastructure is advancing or impeding the school's performance.
 - 2nd Wed – Finance Committee puts together the budget and ensures the fiduciary responsibilities of the school are being met.
 - 3rd Tues - Board Meeting
 - 4th Mon - (odd months) Security Committee discusses what equipment and procedures we need to ensure our kids are kept safe while at school.
 - - (even months) Facility Committee focuses on what the facility needs to continue to function efficiently, including the building and grounds.
 - 4th Tues – Policy Committee reviews and updates school policy and procedures.
